The students were taken by the project representatives to the construction site where they gave information about the raw materials used and their suppliers. The project representatives also laid emphasis on safety and precautions which were adopted at their site, like, safety helmets, emergency ambulance service, safety shoes, etc. The students not only had exposure to a construction site but also learned about the various concepts that are involved in a construction process such as safety of workers, required documents, quality of raw materials, quantity required and the various tests that are required to be undertaken while constructing a building.
