Overview

1. April was characterised by commencement of even semester, joining of new faculty members & empanelment of visiting faculty members, finalisation of the 1st merit list for the new batch (MBA 25),completion of regulatory formalities for re-location of the campus (and annual extension of approval), the online alumni reunion and braving ourselves for the imminent second wave. Its unlikely that the students would return to the campus anytime before August 2021.

Academics

- 2. <u>Commencement of Even Semester (05 Apr)</u>. The even semester formally commenced on 05 Apr and as a notable first, all elective papers in the major specialisations of Marketing and Finance were offered to the 4th semester students. So far the practice had been that there were no choices available to students for pursuit of papers / subjects. We are perhaps the only management Institute under MAKAUT to adopt this.
- 3. <u>Feedback from students for Old Semesters</u>. An online feedback on faculty for the Odd Semesters (I & III) was obtained from students on a structured format. The response was unacceptably low (around 50 per cent). Measures are being instituted to improve the responsiveness of students.

Again 6 faculty members whose contract had expired (they had also appeared for the interview) 5 have been recruited. Four at scales being paid to the existing faculty members and Dr JN Mukhopadhyaya at a scale of Rs 1.4 lakh per month under provisions contained in AWES rules. The Director conducted an orientation programme for the new faculty members which included high tea.

5. <u>Counsellor</u>. The Institute had been without the services of a formal qualified Counsellor since Nov 2017. Ms Priya Sengupta joined AIMK as its formal Counsellor wef 29 Mar 21. The counsellor took her maiden combined online session for students on 29 Apr 21.

Admission

- 6. Round 2: Online GD / PI (09 Apr). Five candidates (4 from Army & 1 from General Category) appeared for the second round of GD /PI. Including these candidates 95 candidates (including the above) have taken the interview for 120 seats.
- 7. <u>De-Classification of Merit List 1 (27 Apr)</u>. The first merit list of 93 candidates was de-classified on 27 Apr.
- 8. **Publicity Drive**. Another publicity drive to draw candidates would be undertaken in May.

Placement

9. Total 12 companies participated in the placement drive during the month (online 11 & in Campus 01) and picked up 6 students, raising the overall numbers placed to 68 (53.3%).

Research & Consultancy

- 10. <u>Association of Indian Management Schools (AIMS) (Sponsored Projects)</u>. Two of our faculty members {Prof (Dr) Malini Majumdar) and Prof (Dr) Prasenjit Kundu} forwarded independent research proposals for funding to AIMS. The details of the proposals are as follows: -
 - (a) Measuring the Acceptability of Flipped Classroom Concept as a Result of Post-Pandemic Disruption Among the Students of Business Schools in West Bengal: Prof (Dr) Malini Majumdar.
 - (b) An Attempt Towards Smart Mining Business Strategies During National Crisis for Socio-Economical Survival : Prof (Dr) Prasenjit Kundu.

Regulatory Bodies / Issues

- 11. NOC from State Govt for Shifting / Re-location (05 Apr). An NOC for shifting of Campus from Directorate of Technical Education (DTE) on behalf of Higher Education Ministry of the State Govt was obtained on 05 Apr.
- 12. <u>Uploading of Documents for Re-location & Extension of Approval (EOA)</u>. The process of uploading of documents for re-location and annual extension of approval on AICTE portal along with deposition of fees was completed on 03 / 05 Apr.
- 13. <u>Submission of Documents to University MAKAUT</u>. Bound set of documents for re-location / extension of approval were submitted at the MAKAUT Office on 30 Mar 21.

- 14. <u>Completion Certificate / Fire Safety Certificate</u>. The concerned authorities have withheld the issuance of fire safety certificate primarily for want of a second exit / staircase in the Amenity Block. Consequently the Completion Certificate is also withheld. This came to light when the Director approached the Divisional Fire Office of the District, which was followed by a visit of the Registrar to the State Fire Safety Office. The GE (I) Project accompanied the Registrar. The MES is constructing a second staircase and the work is expected to be completed in Jun 2021.
- 15. <u>Major Cases for Consideration</u>. The following cases have been initiated for consideration by the BOG:-
 - (a) Re-affiliation of AIMK (& other HEIs) with Rashtriya Raksha University (RRU).
 - (b) Management Courses on Study Leave / Pre Retirement Re-settlement for Army Personnel at AIMK (& AIMT).
 - (c) Offering of Seats in AIMK to Wards of Army Personnel from Friendly Foreign Countries.

16. Selection of AIMK Team for International Data Mining Competition (22 Apr).

Thanks to the initiative of Prof (Dr) Prasenjit Kundu, AIMK's team was selected for the International Data Mining Competition – 2021 along with 95 other teams from 36 countries AIMK is the only Institute from MAKAUT to be selected.
