- 3. <u>FDP on Universal Human Values An AICTE Initiative (18 to 22 Jan).</u> Dr Sweta Rani & Prof Asmita Basu attended an online FDP organised by AICTE on 'Universal Human Values' from 18 to 22 Jan.
- 4. MDP for IIHM (Kolkata). As an ongoing process the third MDP for IIHM Kolkata was conducted online by our faculty from 05 Oct 2020 to 07 Feb 2021. The fourth MDP for the Institute was also started from 05 Jan 2021.
- 5. <u>Empanelment of Visiting Faculty</u>. It was decided to empanel visiting faculty for various specialisations. To set the process in motion an advertisement was taken out in news dailies with last date of application being 30 Jan. More than 40 aspirants have applied. The short listing would be completed by Mar 2021.
- 6. <u>Internal Assessments</u>. With the completion of syllabus for the odd semester separate *viva voce* for each subject were conducted for students with effect from 18 Jan. This would continue for almost a month. Continuous Assessment (CA-1) marks were uploaded on the university portal during the period 21 to 28 Jan.

7. The placement process finally gathered momentum and as on 31 Jan, 23 students (20%) have been placed. During the month pre-placement processes with 07 companies of 79 students were facilitated. Details of placement activities are given at Appendix 'A' attached.

- 14. Re-location Formalities. With the construction work at the new campus nearly complete, it was considered prudent to apply for statutory approvals / clearances / certificates to pave the way for shifting of the campus. The process is to start with obtaining a completion certificate from the municipal authorities and opening of the AICTE portal for uploading the requisite documents. While we have obtained most of the documents, the delay is on account of the AICTE portal not opening up as yet owing to revision of format / procedures. We have also applied for waiver of certain charges. Requisite documents from HQ AWES were received in double quick time.
- 15. <u>Affiliation with Symbiosis (15 Jan)</u>. A letter was written on 15 Jan to the management at Symbiosis to probe the feasibility of AIMK coming under their wings.
