Overview

1. July saw the curtains being drawn by our University for the Academic Year 2019-20. Online assessment of the final year students was carried out. Documents for registration of the Alumni Association were initiated and the process set in motion. A drive was launched to update the alumni database and with the threat of another lockdown looming large, it was considered prudent to shift offices and function from our new campus.

Academics

- 2. Assessment of Students. The University left it to the colleges to decide on the modalities of assessing students for 20 per cent of the total marks allotted to each subject and results were to be submitted by 17 Jul. AIMK decided to conduct a grand viva voce for the final semester students by a panel of faculty members from 08 to 10 Jul. (15 minutes per students) and an hour long online MCQ test covering all subjects. It was a good initiative serving the interests of education, but the performance of the students left much to be desired. The semester was finally declared closed on 15 Jul with the University declaring results on 20 Jul. Contact classes were barely conducted for six weeks during the semester. With UGC recommending exams for final year students uncertainly still looms large.
- FDP on Online Teaching 25 Jul. Faculty members attended an online FDP on online education organised by Association of Indian Management Schools (AIMS) on 25 Jul.

<u>Placements</u>

4. Weekend Group Discussion (GD) Sessions by Faculty for MBA 23. With effect from 25 Jul, faculty started organising two GD sessions on weekends for their mentees from MBA 23 to prepare them for placements. Placements. Eight of our students remain to be placed the placement of another 13 is in jeopardy due to the pandemic fallout. Third party assistance for their placement is being sought.
